Called for A Purpose By Bishop Mark Webb February 1, 2023

By Bishop Mark J. Webb "You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you." – John 15.16

Just a few weeks before the COVID pandemic shut down the world, my wife, Jodi, and I traveled with a group to England for a Wesley Heritage Tour. Some of the individuals on that trip had also traveled with us to the Holy Land just a few years prior. As I was preparing teaching and devotional times for that England trip, I must admit I was doubting I would experience that same "pilgrimage" experience that I did in the Holy Land. That all changed the day we went to Epworth and visited the rectory where the Wesley family lived. As we toured that home, I came face to face spiritually with perhaps the most significant event that occurred in that home. On February 9, 1709, an angry mob (that's a topic for another time) set fire to the rectory where the Wesley family lived. Everyone got out of the house safely, except for five-year-old John. Just as the whole house was about to be consumed by fire, John was rescued through a window by a man standing on the shoulders of another. After the fire, John's mother, Susanna, believing God saved her young son for a reason, often used the words of Zechariah 3.2 to refer to John - "Is this not a brand plucked from the fire?"

Community Church will be doing an Easter Cantata in the spring. It's a choir favorite: Written in Red.


We really need YOU to come and sing with us. If you want a short-term commitment to choir, this is
