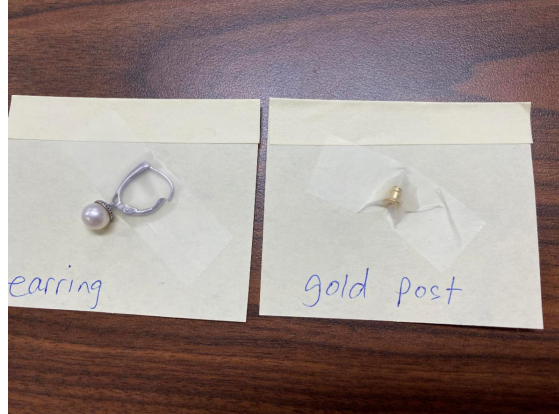

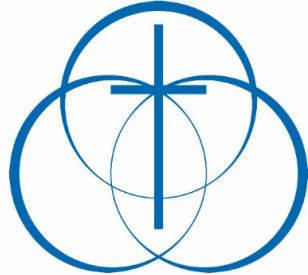
*You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself, your family, or group. If you include your name and an address, the child may be able to write back.
