The Global Methodist Church Transitional Leadership Council (GMC TLC) and Bishop Mark J. Webb are pleased to announce the appointment of the Rev. Dr. Scott Pattison as President Pro Tempore of the Great Lakes Provisional Annual Conference (GL PAC). Dr. Pattison led the Great Lakes Transitional Conference Advisory Team (GL TCAT), the forerunner to the GL PAC, from the fall of 2022 through the first half of 2023. He began transitioning into the role of President Pro Tem of the GL PAC on a part-time basis as of July 1, 2023, when the new conference launched.

The President Pro Tem is tasked with guiding and leading a provisional annual conference when it does not have a resident bishop. Currently, the Global Methodist Church has two Bishops who function as General Superintendents (Bishops Mark Webb and Scott Jones), and the President Pro Tems guide and lead the respective provisional annual conferences. The GMC has yet to determine what the role of bishops will be, how bishops will be selected, and what role the presidents may play going forward. These discussions and decisions will be a part of the Convening General Conference in 2024 and the first General Conference in 2026.

The President Pro Tem has various responsibilities, including teaching and proclaiming the apostolic faith, casting vision, providing spiritual leadership, selecting and working alongside presiding elders (superintendents), caring for and supporting clergy and local churches, and leading the Cabinet (comprised of the President Pro Tem and presiding elders) in clergy appointments to be fixed by the bishop, among many other duties. Dr. Pattison will carry out these responsibilities within the Great Lakes region of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, and Wisconsin.

Dr. Pattison has been serving the new GL PAC as President Pro Tem while also serving simultaneously as Lead Pastor of the ConneXion Church in Kokomo, IN. He will shift to the President Pro Tem role full-time on January 1, 2024, and the Rev. Samuel Padgett will follow him as Lead Pastor of the ConneXion Church on the same date.

“The President Pro Tem role is a sacred responsibility, and it's one that I know Scott does not take lightly,” said Bishop Webb. “I also know and believe that for this season, Scott has been called to this. He has the gifts to do it, and he will be a blessing to the Great Lakes PAC.”

Since its approval by the TLC in mid-June, the GL PAC has grown from 153 churches to around 240 churches going into the Convening Annual Conference this October. The GL PAC will have an opportunity to hear from Dr. Pattison and other GMC leaders at the GL PAC Convening Conference scheduled for October 27-28, 2023, at Crossroads Global Methodist Church in Washington, IL.

THEIR FEET

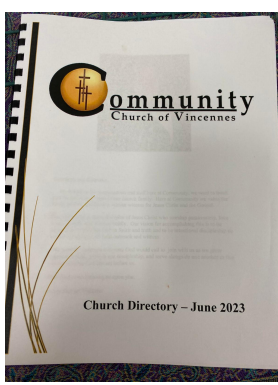
May ___ walk with the wise and not the foolish. Give ___ the courage to stand fast and to remove those stumbling blocks from ___ path.
